<u>Planning</u>

Our planning is based around 'All about me' this term, a copy can be found on the notice board in the lobby as you come in.

We will be talking about 'what we did over the summer' and 'things I like' at carpet time and children can bring in a small item from home to talk about to encourage them to have confidence to speak in front of their peers.

<u>Tapestry</u>

We really like our online journal system to record your child's interests and developments at preschool. This is designed to be a two-way system and for this to work we would encourage you to add your own photos and comments. It can be absolutely anything at all, don't over think it, and we also encourage you to comment/like our posts. If you need any help to do this please just come and ask. We also use tapestry on some occasions to send out general information.

Donations

We kindly ask for donations such as tissues, drawing paper and wipes to help us with our limited funding. We use a lot of these items and our government funding does unfortunately not meet our costs. Any items donated are always very gratefully received.

Housekeeping

To help us out greatly please could you ensure the following:

All children have a **labelled** bag with a spare set of clothes, nappies and wipes if required and any other items appropriate for the weather eg sun hat etc

All water bottles should be labelled with your child's name and contain water only, no juice please. Coats should also have your child's name in them.

No toys should be brought in from home.

Uniform

The nursery has its own sweatshirts and polo shirts with the preschool logo on it for sale at £7 an item. This stops their own clothes getting dirty and also gives them a sense of identity and that it's a school day. This is also a good stepping stone towards going to school. If you would like uniform then come and ask any staff member.
