We will ring you if your child has missed 3 sessions without you contacting us to check all is ok.

It is the cold season again, if your child has medicine, (including Calpol) he/she will not be able to attend the preschool, this is because medicine can mask symptoms of sickness.

Reminder- If your child is sick/has diarrhea he/she will not be able to attend preschool until 48 hours after the last bout.

If your child has an inhaler, please let staff know and fill in the appropriate forms, antibiotics are allowed if needed, however we ask that they are given for 24 hours at home first.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of staff and children, if there is a case of COVID within your home please let us know, when you collect your child a staff member will bring your child to the door to reduce the risk to others.

If your child has COVID it is recommended to keep them off pre-school 3 days after they have tested positive, as long as they have not got a temperature and feel well they can return after 3 days.

We are looking at changes in the natural environment, when you go for a walk please talk to your child about this, i.e. leaves changing colours, conkers ect. We are creating a nature tray, please bring in your finds from your walks to add to our tray.

We are also creating a tree in the corridor to show the change in seasons, we are doing some leaf printing at the moment, please talk to your child about these leaves and the colours.

Tapestry

We enjoy hearing what the children are doing at home, please share their experiences on tapestry, you can upload photos too.

When you go onto Tapestry to upload your child's photos please go onto your child's name, not the Preschool nursery information as this is for staff to share information with you all.

When you receive an observation from us, feel free to comment on it, let us know if your child is doing the same at home.
